Title: More Age/Sex Information On Wisconsin Whitetail Deer Harvest Is Needed

The Problem:

Not enough information is being gathered about the whitetail harvest, at the time of carcass registration, to adequately answer the questions of a concerned public.

There is already a deer registration stub or form being utilized, but it does not generate enough information.

At present, the registration stub or form only distinguishes a whitetail harvest to be either antlered or antlerless. This is not acceptable. The registration form should be changed in such a manner so as to identify the harvest as either adult antlered, adult antlerless, doe fawn, or buck fawn.

The Whitetail Deer resource in the state of Wisconsin is managed, for the most part, by the Department of Natural Resources for its owners, the citizens of this state. As citizens of this state, it is both important and essential that we have as much accurate information available to us as possible regarding the annual whitetail harvest.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Jackson County on April 16th 2007, recommends that the Conservation Congress work with the Department to take action to correct this inadequacy in the amount of whitetail harvest information that is collected and made accessible to the public.
