At present, state law does not permit the use of Archery equipment during the regular firearm general deer season.

Current regulations state" that only shotguns, rifles, muzzle loaders and handguns may be used during the regular firearm general deer season.

Whereas, Wisconsin sportsman should have the opportunity to choose which equipment they wish to use. What this will do is give the sportsman another opportunity as to what kind of hunt he or she can have in the state of Wisconsin.

Allowing the opportunity of archery equipment would not impose any safety concerns or disadvantages to other sportsman out in the field.

There are states that allow the use of archery equipment during their regular firearm general deer season.

BE IT RESOLVED, the conservation congress at its annual meeting held in MONROE County on April 16th, 2007, recommends that the Department of Natural Resources take action to correct this situation by introducing rule changes to legislature **Allowing the use of archery equipment during the regular firearm general deer seasons.**
