

Conservation Congress Resolution

Non-Resident Voting Privileges

Problem:

WHEREAS, The State of Wisconsin has a Conservation Congress and no other bordering state has. There is no other state that allows non-residents to vote on fish and wildlife management rulings.

WHEREAS, This Resolution states that only the residents of Wisconsin shall have the right to vote on the fish and wildlife rulings at the Conservation Congress meetings.

WHEREAS, The Wisconsin State assembly presently has a bill in the assembly #91-2007 that would prohibit all non residents to vote in the Conservation Congress.

WHEREAS, This Resolution recommends that a Conservation Congress person at the door checks for resident identification to register for voting on fish and wildlife management issues.

THEREFORE, Be it resolved, the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Pierce County on April 16, 2007, recommends that the Department of Natural Resources take action to correct this situation and pass this on to the assembly of Wisconsin with the recommendation from Conservation Congress so that the bill 91-2007 can be passed.
