Left over Turkey TAGS #650310

The problem: Some of our neighboring states use a lottery system to sell there hunting permits. In Illinois for example, non-residents are not allowed to apply for any season in the first lottery. During the second lottery residents are given preference, non-residents get what's left over.

BE IT RESOLVED, the conservation congress at its annual meeting held in Walworth County on April 12, 2010 recommends that the Department of Natural Resources take action to correct this situation by introducing rule changes allowing residents to have preference during the turkey tag drawings and first chance for leftover tags. That non-residents would not be considered until all applying residents have received tags where available and the first day for each zones leftover tags would be resident only. Non-residents would only be able to obtain a left over tag during the period when residents could go for a second left over tag. This would also apply for any other lottery, now or in the future.
