## RESOLUTION

Changing the process for selecting the chairman of Conservation Congress study committees.

The Problem: The Chairmen of the Conservation Congress study committees are appointed by the Chairman of the Conservation Congress from the Executive Committee rather than being elected by members of the committee.

Whereas, County delegates of the Conservation Congress are elected by the citizens of the counties where they reside.

Whereas, County delegates of the Congress elect the members of the Executive Council of the Congress.

Whereas, Executive Council members of the Congress elect the Chairman of the Congress.

Whereas, The Chairmen of Conservation Congress study committees are appointed from the Executive Council by the Chairman of the Congress.

Whereas, Members of the Congress Study Committees are selected from a list of County Delegates willing to serve on the committee by the elected Executive Council & elected Congress Chairman.

Whereas, The Chairman of the committees should be elected by the members of the committees to represent the members and opinions of the committee

Be it therefore resolved that the citizens of Fond du Lac County attending the Conservation Congress Spring Hearing on April 11, 2011 petition the Conservation Congress to change the method of selection of the Congress Study Committee Chairman and allow the members of the Committee to select the Chairman by a simple majority vote of the Committee.
