INCREASING FINES FOR HOUNDS RUNNING AT LARGE WHILE BEAR TRAINING/HUNTING

THE PROBLEM; At the present time there are too many complaints of hounds running at large while bear training/hunting onto private lands without permission.

WHERE AS; There are many good hounds men who control their hounds from going onto private lands where they have no permission or have had previous altercations with that private land owner who does not approve of hound training/hunting for bear or doesn't allow bear hound training/hunting on their property. These good hounds men purposely avoid such areas.
