Title: Arms Transportation – Carrying Case. Small game

The Problem:

The 2010 Small Game Hunting Regulations pamphlet Page 4 Definitions continued

Whereas: Enclosed within a carrying case for firearms means The firearm must completely enclosed in a case expressly made for that purpose. The case must fully enclose the firearm by being zipped, buckled tied or otherwise fastened with no portion of the firearm exposed. Homemade cases are legal if they conform to this definition..

Whereas: Carrying cases are not and have never been designed to be a safety device. Restricting what may be qualify, as a carrying case is unreasonable. A carrying case sole purpose is to protect the contents from damage. Therefore any carrying case that totally encloses the firearm would meet the requirements for arms transportation. Any case weather homemade, recycled, ex. an old bow case for shotgun or rifle or pistol , or an old hand bag for pistols would be legal for transportation of a firearm.

Be it resolved:

I request the definition of a carrying case be modified to read. "All firearm must be unloaded and completely enclosed within a carrying case. **And the words Expressly made for that purpose be removed** And the regulations return to the wording and intent used for over 40 years
