Where as Upper and Lower Allequash Lakes have shown the ability in past years to produce quality sized bluegills in numbers.

Where as the lakes are subjected to extreme fishing pressure specifically on bluegills year around, and as a result the average size is greatly reduced.

Therefore, the Department of Natural Resources shall establish a daily bag limit of ten (10) bluegills with a minimum size limit of eight (8) inches.
