Expand Youth Hunt

The problem: 2-day youth hunt seasons only include ages 10 thru 15. Any new hunter older than 15 can buy a Mentored Only License or a First Time Buyer License and all new hunters need a mentor to train them. Currently, these hunters can only hunt during the regular seasons.

Allowing mentored only and first time license holders to hunt during the youth hunt weekend would give them valuable experiences at a time when their mentors have time to train them outside the constraints of the regular seasons when the mentors are also hunting.

This would apply to the youth spring turkey and youth fall deer hunts.

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Waupaca County on April 14, 2014 recommends that the Conservation Congress work with the Department to take action to correct this situation by introducing a rule change allowing anyone with a First Time and/or a Mentored Only License to participate during the 2-day youth turkey and deer hunt weekends.
