## **Establishing a Limit on the Number of Deer Any One License Holder May Harvest in Given Season**

### **The Problem:**

Most hunters have seen a decline in the number of deer they see during the hunting season. Most hunters want to see higher deer numbers and as a result some CDAC units have chosen to try to increase the deer herd by reducing the number of bonus antlerless deer tags available. There are hunters that purchase additional tags and harvest anywhere between 2 and 15 additional deer. It does not make much sense to restrict the number of available bonus antlerless deer tags and allow one hunter to shoot as many deer as they are willing to purchase tags for.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress at its annual meeting held in Fond du Lac County on April 13, 2015, recommend that the Conservation Congress work with the Department of Natural Resources to establish a maximum number of deer that can be harvested by a single license holder above what is provided with their licenses for archery and gun. This maximum number should be able to be adjusted by the WDNR based on fluctuations in the deer herd on a statewide basis or by CDAC units.
