Title: Removal of Waterfowl Blinds on Public Lands

The Problem:

Permanent waterfowl blinds are allowed on public lands beginning 7 days prior to any waterfowl season and must be removed within 7 days of the end of waterfowl season.

This law is loosely followed and hard to enforced due to access to said blinds and locating the builder of said blinds. The result is dangerous and unsightly materials left in the water to decompose on their own, causing a hazard to boaters, swimmers and animals, (namely dogs). Also, permanent blinds have had the effect of giving the builder the idea they have certain rights to the area the blind is located causing major conflicts in the location of the blind.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Conservation Congress work with the department to take action to correct this problem by introducing a rule that all waterfowl blinds on public property be removed at the end of each day.
