Creation of Special-Use Hunting Permits for State Parks

Based on the current state budget plan to remove essential funding from State Park budgets, create a special use permit for hunting and trapping in Wisconsin State Parks where participating sportsmen and women purchase a special-use permit and funds from these permits go directly to the state park where the permit is purchased and used.

Please consider:

Essential monies are being cut from the state park budgets that would have been used to maintain park environments, species, staff, and habitats.


Use special-use permits as a one-season, one-location permit to track seasonal hunter/trapper usage.

Use these permits to generate revenue to directly maintain species and habitat in the specific park where the permit was purchased.

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Conservation Congress work with state DNR staff to establish Special-Use Hunting Permits for WI State Parks where these one-season, one-park permits generate revenue for the specific park to maintain species and habitat, and allow better tracking of hunter/trapper usage.
