Title: Restructuring of Bear Preference Point System to Reduce the Wait Time for Youth Hunters.

The Problem:

Currently in order for a youth to obtain a Class A permit they must start the application process and wait the same amount of years as an adult applicant or have a permit signed over to them by an adult who has been applying for several years. Youth are not able to start applying until age 10 and in some zones they could be adult age before drawing their own permit. The current system of adults signing their Class A permits over to a youth hunter increases the amount of applicants in the pool creating a longer waiting period for all (youth and adult).

Be It Resolved, that the Wisconsin Conservation Congress work with the WI DNR to structure a youth permit drawing with a 1-3 year waiting period for all zones.
