Oppose Executive Committee Proposal to Combine WCC Districts 11 and 12

The Executive Committee has proposed combining Wisconsin Conservation Congress District 11 and 12 into one district.

The state is roughly broken down into 12 districts, by population. Each district elects 2 councilors to the Executive (District) Council.

Currently Milwaukee County, being the most populated county in the state, is District 12 and has 2 councilors on the Executive Council.

District 11 includes Waukesha, Racine and Kenosha Counties, ranked #2, #5 and #8 for population.

If Districts 11 and 12 are combined, the new district containing counties with some of the highest populations totaling *1.7 million would have 2 councilors* on the Executive Council. For comparison, District 1 including 7 northern counties with a *population of approximately 127,000 would also have 2 councilors.*

This proposal would greatly dilute our representation on the District Council, as well as the representation for Waukesha, Racine and Kenosha Counties. It is unfair and disproportional.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the citizens of Milwaukee are opposed to the proposal to combine District 12 with District 11.
