Included is Clark County's application/request for storm damage rehabilitation funding assistance. On September 7th, 2015 a significant weather event took place in Clark County, depositing 5-7" of rain in less than 24hrs; as a result a large percentage of Clark County's ATV/ UTV trails were damaged, with sections being completely submerged. Our trails were closed immediately, and they remained closed for approximately 2 weeks.

Clark County has over 76 miles of ATV/UTV summer trail to maintain and September is still a very busy month for trail riders; there are also local business owners who depend on these visitors. As a result Clark County is requesting a variance to NR 64.14(9)(am)2; we decided it was in the public's best interest to address the damage immediately and, at minimum, repair the trails to a level where they were safe for riders.

As this application is being submitted after April 15th we are also requesting a variance to NR 64.14(11). The majority of our trail system is now open but we are still working to bring the trails to a pre-storm condition. I have included photos and a map identifying the damaged trail areas; there is also a cost breakdown (form 8700-014). We understand there is no guarantee of reimbursement and appreciate any and all consideration provided by the Governor's ORV Council and WIDNR staff. 


