## SFY 2013 CWFP draft Project Priority List:

The State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2013 draft CWFP Project Priority List is now complete and available at <http://dnr.wi.gov/org/caer/cfa/EL/Section/news.html>. The list includes 245 projects for which municipalities submitted Intent to Apply (ITA) forms by December 31, 2011. The list also contains the Priority Evaluation and Ranking Form (PERF) scores for the associated 146 PERFs newly scored by the Regional Construction Management Engineers and a further 96 previously scored PERFs. Three ITA project submissions were deemed ineligible and were not scored.

The department mailed letters to municipalities for each of their projects, providing the project priority score and a 30-day timeframe for submitting any additional information that may affect the project's score. We anticipate finalizing the Project Priority List by the end of April.

Please watch the News page for Updates regarding application submittal deadlines, principal forgiveness, DBE forms, etc. We are still trying to resolve a number of issues for SFY 2013 funding and will provide information as we make decisions.

## SFY 2012 Final Funding Lists:

With the receipt of the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2011 Capitalization Grants which provide SFY 2012 funding for both the CWFP and the SDWLP, the Department has finalized the SFY 2012 Funding Lists for both programs. **For the CWFP**, the Department has \$4,062,506 available in principal forgiveness funds for SFY 2012. This amount consists of \$3,699,315 from the FFY 2011 Capitalization Grant, \$193,191 left over from SFY 2011, and \$170,000 in unutilized ARRA funds. The CWFP principal forgiveness cap for SFY 2012 remains at \$369,932.

The CWFP funding list is split into three sections. The first is the list of projects which submitted SFY 2012 applications prior to the September 30, 2011 principal forgiveness deadline, ranked in priority score order. As there were not enough applications submitted by the deadline to utilize all the principal forgiveness funds a decision was made to offer funds to in-house applications from SFY 2011; these projects are shown in the second section and are also ranked in priority score order. The third section consists of SFY 2012 applications which have been submitted since the September 30, 2011 deadline, listed in order of receipt. All the principal forgiveness has been allocated but loan funds are still available.

**For the SDWLP**, the Department received \$18,433,704 in the FFY 2011 Capitalization Grant of which \$4,871,100 is available in the form of principal forgiveness. A total of \$44,593,850 of loan funds is available for SFY 2012. There were not enough applications submitted by the June 30, 2011 deadline to utilize all the available funds so applications were accepted beyond the deadline on a first come-first served basis. At this time, all principal forgiveness funds are allocated; however there continue to be SFY 2012 loan funds available for new applications.
