Project Description

The Red Hot Fire Department's Forest Fire Protection grant project is primarily based on firefighter protection. We are applying for 10 complete sets of wildland protective clothing to complete the outfitting of our entire fire department membership with full wildland protective clothing. The chainsaw chaps and operator helmets are also safety based for firefighter protection while sawing on wildland fires.

The second part of our FFP grant project is related to completing the outfitting of our brush truck with wildland fire tools. The pulaski axes, drip torch, and drip torch bracket will assist with the suppression of wildland fire.

The balance of the project is the fire prevention/public awareness tool of Smokey Bear. We would like to place a complete Smokey Bear Fire Danger sign in front of our Fire Station to inform and warn our community of the forest fire danger.
