SUBJECT: The Jackson County Wildlife Fund will donate \$20,000 to restore the Lowe Creek ponds

SUMMARY:

The Jackson County Wildlife Fund organization has offered to donate \$20,000 to be used to restoring the Lowe Creek ponds. Local residents were not in favor of removing the ponds, they saw the ponds as a recreational asset to the community and beneficial for wildlife. These scrapes are not connected to Lowe Creek. Pete Segerson, West Central Regional Field Op Supervisor, estimated total project costs for his heavy equipment crew to complete the project. The option was presented to the Jackson County Wildlife organization and they accepted the plan and offered to pay for the project. All permits for the project are completed. Work will commence in 2009.

RECOMMENDATION: I recommend we accept this generous offer.


