

Retirement Resolution

Len C. Polczinski, Acting Air and Waste Regional Leader and Waste Program Supervisor for the Northeast Region at Green Bay retired from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources on May 14, 2010 after 28 years of service to the citizens of Wisconsin.

Len started his career as an LTE in April of 1981. In November of 1982 he was appointed as Community Service Specialist in the Bureau of Solid Waste Management in Madison. In June of 1986 he accepted a voluntary demotion to a Solid Waste Specialist position in Cumberland. He transferred to a Hazardous Waste Specialist position in Green Bay in October, 1988. Len became the Solid Waste-Hazardous Waste, Recycling Unit Leader in February of 1991. In November of 1996, Len was appointed the Northeast Region Waste Team Supervisor, the position he stayed in until his retirement. In addition he accepted a temporary assignment as the Region Air & Waste Team Leader in March of 2009 until he retired.

Len received numerous recognitions during his career including being named NER's Air and Waste employee of the year in 2002.

In addition to his DNR career, Len is an accomplished builder and owner of "Homework Construction Company". He has built and repaired houses and other projects for co-workers and peers throughout the state. He loves to help out co-workers in need.

Len has always been viewed by his peers and staff as a leader. His can do attitude and willingness to help in any way possible will truly be missed. His interaction with the regulated community and general public were always fair and respectful.
