SUBJECT: The Jackson County Wildlife Fund will donate \$5,500 to restore the Lowe Creek Ponds.

SUMMARY:

In 2009, Jackson County Wildlife Fund donated \$20,000 to the WDNR for the creation of two wildlife scrapes on the Lowe Creek State Hunting and Fishing Property, Jackson County. These two scrapes were then build by West Central Regional Field Operations in July and August of 2009. Since then, additional fund raising efforts on the part of Jackson County Wildlife Fund collected \$5,500 which they would like to contribute towards more work on the scrapes. This work will result in enlargement of the scrapes.

RECOMMENDATION: I recommend we accept this generous offer.
