Retirement Resolution

Darlene Hausdorf retired from the Department of Natural Resources on July 7, 2007, after completing more than twenty-eight years of dedicated service to the people of the State of Wisconsin working out of the DNR Cumberland Office.

Dar began her career with the DNR in January of 1979 as a Clerical, Limited Term Employee working at the front desk selling licenses to the public and doing word processing for the staff. At the time, there were only two other employees, working in the old City Hall/Jail building, across the street from the current Service Center location.

Later, Dar's position became permanent and she has worked as a Customer Service Program Assistant (PA) and Customer Service Representative (CSR). Dar's excellent work has been recognized many times over the years, most recently in 2005 when she was named Customer and Employee Services (CAES) Employee of the Year. Recent CSR duties have become more registration oriented and less about license sales. Dar is a very accurate, high producer of completed registrations, in direct assistance to Madison.

Dar's dedication to serving the needs of DNR staff and the public are well known and appreciated in the Service Center and community, where she is held in very high regard.
