

Retirement Resolution

Judith A. Roth retired from the Department of Natural Resources on January 5, 2010, after completing 20 years of dedicated service to the State of Wisconsin.

Judy began her career with the Department of Natural Resources on January 2, 1990 as a Clerical Assistant 1, in the West Central Region, working out of the Eau Claire Service Center. Her work involved a diverse mixture of duties both with front line licensing and customer service, as well as providing Program Assistance to the Waters Program. Judy maintained this position until January 21, 1996 when through a Department reorganization, her duties were changed to solely support the Customer Service and Licensing program.

An opportunity to change program areas and levels of responsibility was presented to Judy on January 12, 2003, and she successfully competed for a position in the Drinking and Groundwater program. Judy's new classification as an Environmental Program Assistant is one she held until her date of retirement. Judy's work in the Drinking and Groundwater program involved working with a geographically as well as population diverse group of municipalities in the West Central Region. This work involved a close relationship with public water system operators and the many laboratory facilities they use to monitor the safe drinking water standards of their water supplies.

Judy's reputation with our regulated community was one with the highest regards. You could contact any municipal system operator within the Region, and they would be able to share instances where Judy provided the highest level of service, and provided it in a friendly, positive way. Her co-workers also think very highly of Judy. She always had a kind word to share and you could count on her to be a positive participant in any conversation.

Judy Roth was a very experienced and knowledgeable employee. She was dedicated and well respected by others and her contributions to Regional and statewide program operations are greatly appreciated. As an outstanding model for the Drinking Water Program staff within the organization, she has enthusiastically taken on roles, such as participating on statewide program work groups, demonstrating leadership, serving as the statewide contact during furloughs for boil water notices, volunteering as an Employee Assistance Program Coordinator, and many others. Judy's many important contributions have been vital to the effective operation of the regional water management team.
