SUMMARY:

In 2011 Ducks Unlimited worked with Dow AgroSciences to provide a donation of two hundred fifty (250) bags of sunflower seed to Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Bureau of Wildlife Management. The fair market value of the seed was \$300 per bag for a total value of \$75,000. The Natural Resources Board accepted this donation at the March 2011 meeting of the board.

Once again Ducks Unlimited and Dow AgroSciences are offering a donation of two hundred fifty (250) bags of sunflower seed to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Bureau of Wildlife Management. The fair market value of the seed is \$300 per bag for a total value of \$75,000.

This generous donation will provide increased hunting opportunities for bird hunters in Wisconsin.
