SUBJECT: Replacement of Bear Representative to the Sporting Heritage Council

SUMMARY:

There has been a resignation from the Sporting Heritage Council by the person representing bear hunting interests.

The council, established by 2011 Wis. Act 168, advises Governor Scott Walker, the Natural Resources Board, and the state Legislature on fishing, hunting, and trapping issues. The current vacant position is one of the five appointed by the Natural Resources Board.


The new nominee will serve out the term of the resignee and may be reappointed at the end of the term in 2016.
