CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE

**THE SITUATION:** When Chronic Wasting Disease, hereafter referred to as CWD, is determined to have been found in a specific area of the state, the area involved, even if there is only one instance, remains in that status and does not have a sunset date where it can become normalized. It is doubtful how these remote areas obtained CDW in the first place.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Conservation Congress at its Spring Hearing, held in Shawano County, State of Wisconsin, on April 8, 2013 requests that any remote area that has had a single case of CDW with no additional cases within a minimal length of time, that this area is reinstated to normal status for allocated activities of CWD-free zones within the state.
