

Resolution Title: Improve deer registration process/opportunity

Currently WI does not allow for additional ways to register deer so hunters must transport their deer to an in-person registration station. Most states and all Midwestern states allow for additional means to register deer. Other states allow for phone-in and on-line registration for ease and convenience to hunters who need to register deer but can't find a registration station that is open when they need it. For years WI turkey and goose hunters have been enjoying on-line and phone-in registration for their birds so a system is already in place in WI to allow for phone and internet registration.

This improvement to the registration process could allow for 3 methods of deer registration and be on par with what other states allow and utilizes today's modern technology and convenience for those choosing to use it. The registration options that hunters could choose from would be:

1. The current in-person registration
2. Phone-in registration
3. On-line (internet) registration



+ = Allows for multiple means of registering deer including phone and internet

- = only allows in person registration

BE IT RESOLVED that at its meeting held in Waukesha County on April 8, 2013 that the Conservation Congress work with the DNR and NRB to take action to correct this situation by improving deer registration that allows for on-line and phone-in registrations .
