Title: Portable Tree Stand Use on State Lands-North of Highway 64

The problem: One of the most dangerous parts of portable tree stand use is set-up and take down- especially during hours of darkness. Current regulations require that tree stands be completely removed from state lands each day causing hunters to place them in pre-dawn hours and/or remove them after hunting hours at night.

National Forest lands as well as county lands in many Wis. Counties (including here in Price Co.) do not require the daily removal of such stands.

Many state lands –especially north of State Highway 64 see light hunter usage compared to more heavily populated areas of southern wis. Previously In southern wis. hunters have rejected the use of portable tree stands for more than daily use. While typically such use has been approved by spring hearing voters in northern counties.

Therefore be it resolved: That the residents of Price county at the April 14,2014 spring hearing ask that rules be written allowing the more than daily use of portable trees stands on all hunt able Wis. State lands north of State Highway 64.
