Uniform state-wide deer vehicle kill data recording


Currently there is no standardized statewide method for recording deer killed in collisions with vehicles. Due to the fact that current record keeping is not handled uniformly on a county to county basis, the valuable information that the department does receive is considered unacceptable for evaluation.

Our newly formed County Deer Advisory Councils need all forms of local data they can get. Uniform Deer car crash history COULD be one more tool for their tool box.

Uniform data recording could include but not limited to the same amount of data that a deer registration includes, and the location to help locate deer hotspots within a county.

Be it resolved that those attending the Annual Conservation Congress Spring Hearings meeting held in Ozaukee County on April 13, 2015 endorses recommending that the Conservation Congress works with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to coordinate with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, and local county law enforcement to create, implement, and make available for distribution, uniform deer vehicle crash data on a statewide basis.
