Crystal Lake

Crystal Lake located in the Townships of Boulder Jct. and Plum Lake, contains a large population of the invasive species, smelt. The presence of this invasive less than 100 yards from Big Muskellunge Lake is a significant threat to that lake. Also, due to the large numbers of campers and picnickers using Crystal Lake there is an excellent chance smelt could be transported to other lakes in the area. The UW Limnology lab did an unsuccessful study to eliminate the smelt. The Department of Natural Resources shall be required to chemically treat Crystal Lake to remove this invasive threat.
