September 1st Bear Hunt opener

The purpose of this resolution is to address the issue of inconsistent bear season opening dates. Often times the bear season opens in the second week of September and is adversely affected by the Acorn drop and other mid September agricultural factors. Opening the Wisconsin bear season at the earliest date allowable will help increase the success rate and hunter satisfaction rate. Many states including our neighbor Minnesota open the bear season Sept 1st or earlier annually, often times allowing Minnesota hunters that hunt near Wisconsin border counties the opportunity to hunt before our Wisconsin hunters.

BE IT RESOLVED, By opening the Wisconsin bear season annually on Sept 1st Wisconsin bear hunters will have greater success which will positively impact the harvest quotas and decrease bear predation on Wisconsin's deer herd.
