**Title: Discharging firearms in Non Approved Areas.**

**The Problem:**

There are Tribal Members hunting, making drives, and discharging their firearms on State Lands the Friday before the opening of the gun deer season.

This is happening while hunters are checking and setting their stands in clothing that is not blaze orange.

Wisconsin Law states, that no one can discharge a firearm unless it is in an approved shooting range the Friday before season. The law needs to be changed to protect the public safety to include all hunters in the State of Wisconsin.

**Be It Resolved,** The Wisconsin Conservation Congress (W.C.C.) at its annual meeting held in Oneida County on April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012 recommends the Conservation Congress work with the Department of Natural Resources to take action to correct this situation by introducing changes in the law to protect the public safety.
