## RESOLUTION

**Title:** Fees for certain fish and game licenses issued to resident senior citizens

**The Problem:** Hunter participation in the 65 and older age category drops off markedly. Wisconsin is regularly ranked as one of the ten worst states in which to retire. The cost of permits/licenses to hunt and fish are one barrier to participation.
