INCREASING FINES FOR DOG/HOUNDS RUNNING AT LARGE WHILE TRAINING OR HUNTING

THERE FORE be it resolved here in _____ county on April 9, 2012 that the citizens present request that the Wisconsin Conservation Congress support increasing the minimum fine from \$25.00 to \$250.00 and increase the maximum fine from \$50.00 to \$500.00 for dogs or hounds running at large on private property without permission while in the act of training or hunting with the DNR and legislators to implement such a change.
