The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources incorporates contingency measures into the Attainment Demonstration to satisfy requirements of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.

The contingency measures are to be triggered or in place for the ozone season following the milestone year should a failure occur in achieving emission reductions. The ozone seasons of 2003, 2006, and 2008 are covered by two contingency measures that are part of this attainment demonstration, VOC reductions from the On Board Diagnostic provisions of the State's I/M program and NOx reductions from the emission reduction requirements on Large Electric Generating Units.

The emission reductions have been calculated using the Adjusted ROP Baseline Inventory for the milestone years and equal a combined 3%.

The 2003 ozone season contingency plan achieves 3% of the 2002 milestone as follows:

VOC 0.12% or 0.4 tpd  
NOx 2.88% or 10.46 tpd

The 2006 ozone season contingency plan achieves 3% of the 2005 milestone as follows:

VOC 0.3% or 0.97 tpd  
NOx 2.7% or 9.74 tpd

The 2008 ozone season contingency plan achieves 3% of the 2007 milestone as follows:

VOC 0.6% or 1.94 tpd  
NOx 2.4% or 9.00 tpd

The Department commits to working with EPA to address any shortfalls that may occur due to unforeseen circumstances.
