Hi Andy,

Thank you for the phone conversation this morning to discuss the latest status update report for the V & L Stripping Site. To summarize our discussion:

- 1. DNR has been in contact with DHS regarding the off-site vapor sampling and inability to gain access. DHS will be sending toxicological information to the homeowners, which the DNR will follow up with a third and final request for access.
- Another round of on-site sub-slab sampling is not necessary as the VMS blower has been turned back on. The summa canisters may be used for sampling of the sanitary sewer manholes. Prior to sampling sewers, the lateral should be confirmed to discharge to Lincoln, and a brief workplan should be submitted to the DNR for review and approval.
- 3. Recent soil sampling shows increases of contamination in the northeastern portion of the property. Based on this increase, and sub-slab vapor concentrations still being high, DNR recommends a soil remedy to reduce the source of contamination, which will include the submittal of a remedial action options report (RAOR) that can be combined with the chosen remedial action plan (RAP). Additional soil sampling may be warranted to better define the area of soil contamination for the proposed remedy.
