Ben – I have included a few items discussed and promised during the Innovative Properties Group, LLC/One Hour Martinizing 02-05-217270 enforcement conference on November 1, 2022.

<u>Wis. Stat. ch. 292</u> and the <u>Wis. Admin. Code NR 700 rule series</u> include DNR's regulatory authority for contaminated sites in Wisconsin. A summary of the NR 700 Process and & Timeline is outlined in Fact Sheet <u>RR967</u>.

Wis. Admin Code ch. NR 716 outlines what is needed for a proper investigation. Various site investigation related resources/guidance can be found at DNR's Site Investigation Toolkit website: https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Brownfields/SIToolkit.html.

<u>Soil Standards:</u> Soil Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) for soil to groundwater pathway and direct contact (non-industrial and industrial) pathway can be found at the following DNR website: https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Brownfields/soil.html, then under the Soil RCLs tab, click the link: RCL Spreadsheet for use with macro-enabled Excel program. Soil to groundwater pathway and non-industrial direct contact RCLs would apply for a commercial contaminated gas station site.

<u>Groundwater Standards</u>: (Enforcement Standards and Preventive Action Limits) can be found in Table 1 of Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 140, Groundwater Quality at the following link: https://docs.legis.wisconsin.gov/code/admin code/nr/100/140.pdf.

<u>Vapor Screening Levels:</u> Vapor Risk Screening Levels (VRSLs) for sub-slab/soil gas vapors and vapor action levels (VALs) for indoor air can be found at the following DNR website: https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Brownfields/Vapor.html, then under the Screening Levels tab, click the link Wisconsin Vapor Quick Look-Up Table for Indoor Air VALs and VRSLs. This link includes a table of the volatile organic compounds (VOCs) frequently encountered at contaminated sites. VRSLs and VALs on the table are listed for Residential, Small Commercial, and Large Commercial/Industrial settings. For other chemicals not listed on this table, refer to the link on this webpage for calculating other vapor screening levels. The indoor air standard of 180 ug/m³ referenced during the call is outlined in the Guidance Wisconsin Vapor Quick Look-up Table Indoor Air Vapor Action Levels and Vapor Risk Screening Levels, Guidance Wisconsin Vapor Quick Look-U Table.

The DNR cannot recommend consultants/contractors. Here is a link to the full list of contractors RR-024. Per your specific request, here are a few of the consultants working on other dry cleaner sites in the area: Enviroforensics, SCS, AECOM, Bay West, Fehr Graham, and Stantec. I pulled these contractors by searching the DNR online database, BRRTS on the Web (BOTW), for other open dry cleaner sites and identified what consultants were working on the sites. The consulting firms' contact information are on the full list of contactors RR-024.


