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Good Morning Josie:

Terracon is in the process of contacting HVAC contractors who might assist in introducing more fresh air into the building by mechanical means as suggested by WDNR following the April site visit. We are hopeful that the contractor(s) can coordinate a visit to the site during Terracon's next round of groundwater monitoring scheduled for the week of 8/21. We will keep you updated in this regard.

WDNR also suggested air sampling with the existing mitigation system on and off on consecutive days to determine if negative pressure inside the building may be contributing to the

problem. It is my understanding that Terracon will be working with Dr. Neziri to conduct that sampling in the near future and will communicate those results to you.

With respect to remedial action and/or additional soil sampling within the source of the drycleaner, there has been little progress on this issue due to our client's lack of funding. Again, our client is in the process of seeking contribution from the former owner of the building, to hopefully free up additional funds that can be infused into remediation efforts.

We will keep you updated on the above. Thank you. Should you have any questions, please advise.
