Jenna & Dillon,

Thank you for sending the off-site vapor sampling results to me. First round of results look good, however there are some elevated detections in the sub-slab and indoor air at the clinic, although below their respective VALs and VRSLs.

When TCE is a contaminant of concern, DNR now recommends that passive, long duration (i.e. 7-10 day) indoor air sampling be performed after the initial sampling event. DNR has a presentation and recorded webinar on passive long-duration sampling from last November that can be found here: <u>RR Program</u> <u>Presentations & Training Library | Wisconsin DNR</u>

I would recommend reaching out to the lab to discuss sampler options that best fit your situation as there are multiple brands of passive samplers available. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding the passive sampling.
