The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in consultation with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR), reviewed the Foth/Envirocon Joint Venture (FE-JV) email dated June 15, 2018, updating the status of the cleaning and re-coating of the bulkhead sheet pile wall. It seems the procedures utilized for wall cleaning and re-coating, as originally proposed in Tech Memo #18-2 and modified in the May 15th email, have adequately performed. In addition, as noted in your email, the long-term monitoring and maintenance of the bulkhead sheet pile wall will be addressed by Northern States Power Company (NSPW) if any repairs or recoating is needed in the future. Therefore, EPA approves the processes used for the wall.
