RE: EPA concurrence that dredge work is complete at the Site Ashland/NSP Lakefront Superfund Site

Dear Mr. Ealy:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in consultation with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR), concurs that Northern States Power Company of Wisconsin (NSPW) has completed the dredging component of the Phase 2 wet dredge remedy at the Ashland/NSP Lakefront Superfund Site (Site). The final post-dredge Surface-Weighted Average Concentration (SWAC) for Phase 2 was below the performance standard of 9.5 ppm tPAH; therefore, NSPW can continue with placement of the restorative layer at the Site.
