The WDNR has completed a review of the current plans and specification for the Kreher Park boat launch within the Ashland Superfund site. The WDNR's review is not an engineering review nor is it a detailed review of the plans and specifications. The DNR's review was conducted to determine if the proposed work will maintain protectiveness of the remedy. The WDNR previously provided comment on the initial boat launch plans and specifications that were included in the EPA's comments to the City of Ashland dated March 10, 2020. It appears the WDNR's comments have been addressed. It also appears that the proposed work will maintain protectiveness of the remedy and the WDNR has no further comments at this time. Circumstances encountered during the work may result in a situation where the WDNR may have concerns that remedy protectiveness is not being maintained.
