Phil:

As requested, attached are photographs showing the soil stockpiled at the Former Barksdale Works site from the WisDOT Boyd Creek bridge project. The photographs were taken on June 23, 2020. Most of the soil remains too wet to slope and grade, so we plan to leave it uncovered at this time to dry. The soil will continued to be monitored for workability on a weekly basis.

A total of 106 dump truck loads of soil have been hauled to the site to date, which includes the following:

- 37 loads on 5/26/2020
- 39 loads on 6/1/2020
- 9 loads on 6/18/2020
- 21 loads on 6/22/2020

Assuming 13 to 15 cubic yards of soil per load, an estimated 1,400 to 1,600 cubic yards of soil has been hauled to the site. WisDOT contractors have indicated that they do not plan to haul any additional soil to the site.

As requested, attached are photographs showing the soil stockpiled at the Former Barksdale Works site from the WisDOT Boyd Creek bridge project. The photographs were taken on June 1, 2020 and June 10, 2020. The soil remains too wet to slope and grade, so we plan to leave it uncovered at this time to dry. The soil will continued to be monitored for workability on a weekly basis.

A total of 76 dump truck loads (37 loads on 5/26/2020 and 39 loads on 6/1/2020) of soil have been hauled to the site to date. Assuming 13 to 15 cubic yards of soil per load, an estimated 900 to 1,200 cubic yards of soil has been hauled to the site. WisDOT contractors are planning to resume hauling late this week or early next week.

Brad, Cary, and Eric,

The WDNR has reviewed the addendum letter for the Former Dupont Barksdale Works Site dated May 18, 2020. This email serves as an approval to your exemption request under NR 718.05 with the following considerations:

- The amount of soil stored shall not exceed 2500 cubic yards.
- The soil shall be covered and anchored per NR 718.05 requirements.
- The soil shall not be stored for more than 6 months without an approved Interim Action/Soil Management Plan.
- A Interim Action/Soil Management Plan shall be submitted within 4 months, by September 19, 2020, to allow for a 60 day review period.
