Good Afternoon Scott,

DNR has reviewed the information provided in the response to the RADR comments. Based on current information and recent justification provided, it's difficult to determine that vertical extent of contamination is defined at this time. One concern is that piezometers have not been sampled since December 2020, and the injection may have pushed contamination downward. Prior to submitting a workplan for additional investigation, we recommend sampling piezometers at a minimum to show vertical extent hasn't been affected by the injection.

It appears the injection is working with the drastic decrease in TOC, but hard to say at this time if only two more rounds of sampling will be enough, but it can be revisited after those two rounds. We will still need annual sampling, at a minimum, of the entire MW network as well. Sub-slab sampling will also help determine effectiveness of the injection.
