Jeff – Thank you for notifying the DNR that construction of the GETS will extend through July 31, 2022, and that the associated management of contaminated soil specified in the [Materials Management Plan \(MMP\)](#) will extend beyond the 6-month approval period specified in the [DNR’s October 6, 2021 letter](#). The DNR approves your request to continue to managing contaminated soil through July 31, 2022 in accordance with MMP and requirements listed in the October 6, 2021 approval letter.

We understand from a recent conversation with JCI/Tyco that the generation of contaminated water during construction of the GETS will end on or about February 2022, when there is typically no surface water flow in Ditch A. If the treatment of the water from construction dewatering extends into time when surface water flow in Ditch A resumes, then an updated groundwater management plan must be provided to the DNR. The update plan must demonstrate how treatment of the construction dewatering water will occur without disrupting capture and treatment of the Ditch A surface water.

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources approved the “Groundwater Extraction and Treatment System - Materials Management Plan Approval to Manage Contaminated Soil under Wis. Adm. Code § NR 718.12 and Response to Other Management for Contaminated Soil and Groundwater JCI/Tyco FTC PFAS, 2700 Industrial Parkway South, Marinette, WI DNR BRRTS Activity #: 02-38-580694” through April 6, 2022. Due to delays caused by weather, supply chain, and COVID-19 we will continue to generate soil and groundwater that will be managed following the Materials Management Plan through July 31, 2022, with the exception that water generated during dewatering processes at EX-4, EX-5, EX-6 and the junction vault at Edwin and Oak View Streets will no longer be direct discharged to Ditch B. Water generated at those locations generated after December 10, 2021 was or will be collected and treated in the Ditch A treatment system.

Please confirm the WDNR’s approves the extension request.
