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Hello Jayson -

I hope this email finds you well. I am reaching out regarding the Site Investigation Work Plan for the environmental assessment at 3M Menomonie. According to the Responsible Party letter issued by the DNR on October 25th, 3M is required to appropriately scope our site investigation and submit a Work Plan within 60 days, by December 26th.

As you are aware, 3M has scoped the site investigation which will include shallow soil samples, deep soil samples, and groundwater sample collection at multiple locations across the site. These details were provided to you in our November 17th email correspondence. Since our last communication, 3M's consultant has successfully performed the initial shallow soil sampling on portions of the site ahead of the onset of winter conditions. 3M and Tetra Tech have also been working diligently to prepare and submit a Site Investigation Work Plan by the December 26th deadline.

It is standard to have these types of reports follow an internal 3M review process. Our upper management, however, is out of the office through the end of the year for the holidays and as such will not be able to review the report before the target submittal deadline. 3M is respectfully requesting an extension to allow time for our management to review the Work Plan ahead of submittal. We anticipate the Work Plan will be submitted in early January.
