It is recommended that you take a hands-on trapper education course if at all possible. You learn and retain so much more and in most classes are able to set out traps during class and in some cases leave them overnight.

As a last resort, if there is no class available in your area or you are a non-resident you could consider taking the Correspondence Course through the mail which takes approximately 4-6 weeks to complete. Note: Trapper Education Courses are not as numerous and widespread as Hunter Safety Courses throughout the year. It is not uncommon to have to drive an hour or more to get to a course nearest you.
