### Check one:

I will drop off my youth on Thursday at 5:00 PM, March 28th, at the Wascott 4 Seasons Recreation Club and ball field, and pick him/her up on Saturday by 1 PM.

I will commute my youth to and from the Wascott 4 Seasons Recreation Club and ball field on Crystal Lake Road on all three days. I will make sure we arrive by 5 PM on Thursday, March 28th, and will stay until after the mentor and youth hunter return from roosting; I will drop off my youth on Friday, March 29th, 4:15 AM and will pick them up around 6:30 PM. I will arrive with them on Saturday by 4:15 AM, and will pick them up around 1:00 PM.

- Camouflage – Hat, face mask, jacket(s), gloves, and pants.
- Footwear – warm boots with good traction soles. Waterproof is preferred.
- Warm weather clothes – temperatures commonly are below freezing.
- Sleeping bag, air mattress or cot, and pillow for sleep over.
- Toiletries (tooth brush, comb, hair brush, etc.)
- Shotgun with full or tighter choke. If you don't have one, let us know and we'll provide. (*Shotgun must not have reflective parts. Shiny parts must be camouflaged with non-marring tape.*)
