Ages 12 to 15 - on the day of the hunt. Persons under age 18 must have parental/guardian consent. Age 16 or older. No previous gun deer hunting experience.

All applicants must have Hunter Education Certificate or provide photocopy of receipt of course currently enrolled in, or a letter from the instructor verifying enrollment in upcoming course.

#### Rules

- 1. All applicants must be accompanied by a chaperone during the hunt and workshop. Applicants may select a chaperone (i.e. family or friend). This person will not be allowed to hunt or carry a firearm and must be at least 21 years old and have deer hunting experience.
- 2. Successful applicants and their chaperones are required to attend one workshop in order to participate in the hunt.
- 3. All students must possess a valid WI deer firearm hunting license by the time of the hunt. All students will be issued a **BONUS** either-sex permit.
- 4. If the number of qualified applicants exceed class limits, applicants will be selected randomly.
- 5. ONLY students and chaperones will be admitted to the workshop. Students completing the course will be issued their permits on the day of the hunt during check-in.
- 6. Waivers are available for students unable to afford the fee. **DO NOT SEND FEE NOW.** Workshop fees are \$40.

- 8. The hunt will be held all day on Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup>.
- 9. CWD testing has been performed on deer taken in Sandhill Wildlife Area since November 2002. To date there have been no positive cases reported. All deer will be sampled for CWD.

- 1. Select the workshop dates you can attend. This does not guarantee you a spot. You will only be considered for the workshop dates you have selected.
- 2. Provide name, address, phone number, email address, birth date, Hunter Education completion date (or photocopy of class receipt) and signature.
- 3. Only ONE application is permitted for each student.
- 4. You must have a parent or guardian's permission if applicant is less than 18 years old.
- 5. The chaperone section must be filled out. Chaperones can only assist ONE student.
- 6. If the number of applications exceed capacity, a random draw will be used to select hunters.
- 7. The application deadline is July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.
- 8. All successful applicants will be notified by July 18<sup>th</sup>. Non-selected applicants will not be notified.
