

# FISH MANAGEMENT REPORT 93

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## ABSTRACT

An inventory of the recreational facilities of the Wisconsin waters of the Mississippi River was conducted in 1976. Results are presented and compared to those found in a 1968-69 inventory. Individual inventory forms and maps locating each facility are presented in appendices.

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## INTRODUCTION

In 1968-69, an inventory of recreational attractions and facilities was conducted on the Mississippi River in Wisconsin (Fernholz et. al., 1970). Although this report served as a valuable basic inventory, the Upper Mississippi River Conservation Committee (UMRCC) decided that a revision and up-date in all five states was necessary.

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Mississippi River Work Unit and the Recreation Work Group of the Great River Environmental Action Team (GREAT I) jointly undertook this inventory on the Wisconsin portion of the Mississippi River from Prescott, Wisconsin, to Dubuque, Iowa. The data provided will be useful as public information. It will assist planners and managers and will serve as a basic inventory for the Great River Environmental Action Team (GREAT) in the development of a long range plan for the Mississippi River.

This report is an inventory of boat landings, access sites, boat rentals and services, picnic, swimming, camping areas, and nature trails of Wisconsin waters of the Mississippi River (Figure 1). A section on scenic bluffs along the river is also included.

## METHODS

A uniform inventory form was developed to serve the needs of all five states on the UMRCC and GREAT. Data for this report were collected on-site and recorded on the inventory form using standardized definitions (Appendix 1). Resulting information was summarized and compared to the 1969 inventory. All facilities were located on maps for future reference.

## RESULTS

Inventory results are summarized by pool (Table 1) and by county (Table 2). Table 3 compares user facilities inventoried in 1969 with those found in the present (1976) inventory. All sites are identified by number and mapped by county (Figures 2-9).

One recreation site exists for every 1.1 mile along the 230.6 river miles bordering the State of Wisconsin. This includes 117 boat launching ramps (92 public and 25 private) with parking facilities for approximately 2,707 cars and trailers. Fifty-six facilities providing boat rental and services to the public were recorded.

The Mississippi River bordering Wisconsin has 4 state parks and 8 village and county parks that offer public camping facilities along with 15 private facilities for a total of 1,508 designated camp sites. In addition, a substantial amount of camping takes place on the sand bars along the main channel of the Mississippi River and within its corridor.

Picnic areas are common with 35 acres containing approximately 2,000 picnic tables. All of the pools provide at least one public facility totalling 32 sites. Only two pools (3 and 10) provide private picnic facilities. Eight of the 11 pools provide at least one swimming area. Thirteen are considered private and 4 public.

Scenic bluffs are a unique feature of the river and Wisconsin is very well endowed with 137 miles. The majority are privately owned and it is for that reason their recreational value in the natural state must be recognized. Scenic overlooks worth noting include Bona Vista at Alma, Granddads Bluff at La Crosse, and Old Settlers Overlook three miles north of Genoa, Wisconsin. These sites provide a spectacular view of the Mississippi River and its corridor. In addition, Brady's Bluff in Perrot State Park provides a unique view of the Mississippi River and Wyalusing State Park provides an overview of the Wisconsin River and its confluence with the Mississippi River. The Trempealeau Mountain, located in Perrot State Park, Pool 6, is a unique feature with access to it only by water routes.

Seven fishing barges located immediately below Locks and Dams 4, 5A, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 11 provide an excellent fishing opportunity. Although four of these barges are located on the opposite side of the river (Locks and Dams 4, 6, 8, and 9), access to barges located below Locks and Dams 4, 5A, 6, 8, 9, and 11 exists from the Wisconsin side of the river.

#### CONCLUSIONS

Comparison with the results of the 1969 survey (Table 3) shows both additions and deletions of sites. The number of private facilities fluctuate more than public facilities as people move to and from the river. There is a noted decrease in rental and service facilities. The reason is unknown although a trend for people to own their own equipment and purchase larger boats and motors may be a factor.

Public boat launching facilities have increased since 1969 with the largest number in the lower pools. Presently there is a public launching ramp for every 2.5 miles of river. There is a demonstrated need for public access development in Prescott and below Lock and Dam 5. Several access sites, particularly in Pool 4 (Lake Pepin) have a definite need for improvement and expansion to provide for launching of larger craft and improved parking facilities. Comments regarding specific sites are noted in the quality evaluation portion of this report.

Two small access sites were abandoned in Pool 9. The abundance of access sites in this pool coupled with the lack of need caused abandonment.

The number of public and private swimming areas has decreased since 1969. The major decline was noted in the upper pools which may be due to a decline in water quality. The inability of the smaller cities to provide a full-time life guard is also a factor. Swimming is primarily concentrated in the larger cities of La Crosse and Prairie du Chien and adjacent to the sand bars along the main channel of the Mississippi River. These sand bar areas are not recorded in this report.

Camping facilities have not increased significantly since 1969, but camp sites have increased (600 sites). The increase occurred by the expansion of existing facilities. Again sand bars along the main channel of the river are used heavily, however, they are not specifically managed for camping. The expansion of camping facilities should be considered in all pools.

Picnic areas are an important part of the recreational use of the Mississippi River. There is a slight increase in the total number of public picnic areas since 1969 but a decrease was noted in Pools 10 and 11. Perhaps development of picnic areas in or adjacent to already developed access sites could be implemented. Maintenance of these areas is considered a problem. The number of private picnic areas has decreased significantly. Apparently picnicing is not a profitable venture.

All land and water within the river system are important hunting, fishing, and trapping areas. Over 90 percent of this area is owned or controlled by the federal government; therefore, it was included in this report.

Although there has not been an increase in the amount of scenic bluffs since 1969, there has been an increase in the need to recognize these areas as valuable resources in their natural state. A change in definition effected an increase in the 1976 inventory compared to 1969 (Table 3). Since the majority are privately owned, the current bluff development boom is threatening to destroy this part of the river's recreational resource. Protection measures are definitely needed.

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APPENDIX II: Standardized Definitions For Inventory

Facility or Site Name

Complete official name or accepted local name. Scenic areas are considered as "recreation facilities" and are noted. Wildlife refuge lands are included with adjoining states coordinating efforts to insure against duplication or deletions.

Location

River Mile, Pool: Distance in miles from the confluence of the Ohio River with the Mississippi River (commonly noted on navigation maps, etc.). Pool number refers to the pools formed by the series of numbered locks and dams on the River.

County, State: The county and state in which the facility is located.

Ownership

Public: Agency Code identifies the owner of the facility. Codes used in this column are noted on the second page of the form. The main purpose of the codes is to expedite the recording process. Address of Facility Manager refers to the full address (including zip code) of the facility manager. The manager's name and job title should be given where applicable.

Private: Name of Owner refers to the name and address of the owner or manager of privately owned facilities. Motels, resorts, etc., without boating, fishing, swimming or trail facilities are not to be inventoried.

Land Sizes (Acres)

Undeveloped: The total acres of undeveloped land. Includes areas held in "reserve" for further development, wildlife areas, areas with only trails, etc. Under the quality evaluation column, the acres "suitable" for development are recorded (this might be only a part or all of the undeveloped acres).

Developed: The total acres of developed land. Includes camping areas, picnic areas, beaches, boat ramps, etc. These areas normally require maintenance.

Boating Access

Ramps: Parking Spaces refers to the accompanying boat trailer and automobile parking area capacity. One parking space is assumed to be approximately 10 feet by 45 feet or 450 square feet. Surface refers to the type of ramp surfacing. Codes are: G - gravel, H - hard surfaced (concrete, asphalt or metal), C - concrete plank (alternating hard surfaced and gravel), and N - nonsurfaced (includes high and low water earth ramps). Fee charged for launching boats is indicated with an "X". If no fee is charged, this column is blank.

Marina, No. of Slips: The number of boat slips.

Boat Rental: In facilities renting boats, the total number of boats available for rent.

Private Boats: In areas that contain concentrations (3 or more) of private boats and/or launches, the approximate number of private boats is recorded.

Services: Any services associated with boating (including dry dock, gas, maintenance, groceries, etc.), are indicated with an "X". If no services are offered, left blank.

Camping (Sites)

Group: Number of specific camping units specifically designated for use by groups (camping clubs, etc.).

Individual: Camping units not designated for group use only recorded as the total number of unit space available. In areas without specifically delineated camping units, a campground will be assumed to be developed at 6 units per acre.

Boat Access: These sites are generally considered "primitive" and are accessible only by boating. This category would consist mainly of camping areas on islands or on refuge lands. Most of these do not have designated camping areas. Although this type of camping can occur most any place (at least at some time during the season), the intent of this category is to identify areas where it

is common to have at least moderate concentrations (3 or more) of campers. In areas of known uses, the approximate peak number of camp units is recorded or maximum concentrations of 5 units per acre is assumed (which ever is the greater number).

Fishing Pier or Barge

If piers or barges are designated for fishing, the number of piers and barges are recorded.

Hunting/Trapping

Acres: The approximate number of acres designated or open to hunting or trapping. This would apply not only to Fish and Wildlife Service refuge lands, but also other publicly owned lands. Privately owned lands are not included.

Hunting: If hunting occurs in the area, the species most commonly hunted is noted. Codes used in this column are noted on the second page of the form.

Trapping: If trapping occurs in the area, the species most commonly trapped is noted. Codes used in this column are noted on the second page of the form.

Outdoor Education Area

Outdoor Education Areas, are indicated with an "X". Includes interpretive nature trails (guided or self-guided), environmental education centers, etc.

Designated Swimming Areas

Those (public or private) swimming areas designated by signs, buoys, etc. They may be staffed with lifeguards or may be areas where you swim at your own risk.

Beach Size: The square feet of beach area (defined by limits of sand surfacing or sand and grass within an area designated by posts, cable, fence, etc. as beach).

Swimming Area Length: The length in feet of the water frontage devoted to swimming. The width of swimming areas will be assumed to be the Red Cross recommendation of not more than 100 feet.

Undesignated Swimming Area

Areas not administered (public or private) or designated for swimming, but at which swimming does occur (dredge spoil beaches, etc.) are noted with an "X".

Trails

The length of trails in tenths of miles designated for use for hiking, horseback riding, bicycling, snowmobiling, or cross-country skiing. One trail may be designated for more than one use (hiking - 3.0; snowmobiling - 3.0, etc.). The number of miles designated for each use is recorded.

Quality Evaluation

This is primarily a "remarks" column. Information is recorded on scenic areas, the condition of facilities (boat launch needs dredging, rest rooms need restoration, boat ramp needs rebuilding, good condition, etc.), potential impacts of dredge spoil, potential beneficial use of dredge spoil, acres (of those undeveloped) that are "suitable" for development, etc.




Figure 1. Map of the inventory area of the Mississippi River showing Wisconsin county boundaries, pools, and river mile numbers.




Figure 2. Guide to recreational facilities along the Mississippi River in Pierce County.




Figure 3. Guide to recreational facilities along the Mississippi River in Pepin County.




Figure 4. Guide to recreational facilities along the Mississippi River in Buffalo County.




Figure 5. Guide to recreational facilities along the Mississippi River in Trempealeau County.






Figure 7. Guide to recreational facilities along the Mississippi River in Vernon County.




Figure 8. Guide to recreational facilities along the Mississippi River in Crawford County.




Figure 9. Guide to recreational facilities along the Mississippi River in Grant County.
