You must write the confirmation number on this tag. Retain this tag until meat is consumed.

# 2016 Wisconsin Deer Carcass Tags

## Antlerless deer carcass tag types:

An antlerless deer is defined as any deer without antlers or any deer with both antlers being shorter than three inches in length.

### Farmland (Zone 2) Antlerless Deer

- One or more is included with the purchase of an archer/crossbow and gun deer license.
- Valid for tagging an antlerless deer only in the Farmland Zone, DMU and land type (public or private) specified on the tag.
- Tag is not season- or weapon-specific and may be used during any open gun, archery or crossbow season with appropriate license.
- Class A & C disabled permit holders and certain active duty military personnel on leave may use this tag on antlerless deer harvested in any DMU on the land type specified on the tag, including buck only DMUs.
- Junior license holders can request Farmland (Zone 2) Antlerless Deer Tags in addition to the Junior Antlerless Deer Tag included with their deer hunting license. Visit the "Antlerless deer tag availability" page on [dnr.wi.gov](http://dnr.wi.gov) to see how many Farmland (Zone 2) tags are included with the purchase of a license in each DMU.

### Bonus Antlerless Deer

- Valid for tagging an antlerless deer in the Zone, DMU and land type (public access or private) specified on the tag. This tag is not season- or weapon-specific.
- This tag can be purchased through any license agent or online (\$12 resident, \$20 non-resident, \$5 youth ages 10-11) at a rate of one tag, per person, per day until sold out or the hunting season ends.
- Bonus tag sales begin at 10 a.m. on the following days for each Zone, until sold out:
  - ⇒ **Monday, August 15** — Northern and Central Forest (Zones 1)
  - ⇒ **Tuesday, August 16** — Central Farmland (Zone 2)
  - ⇒ **Wednesday, August 17** — Southern Farmland (Zone 2)
  - ⇒ **Thursday, August 18** — all zones can be purchased
- Additional **Bonus Metro Sub-unit Antlerless Deer** tags may be available in select DMUs. These tags are Zone, DMU, Metro Sub-unit and land type specific. This tag is only valid for tagging an antlerless deer harvested within the county portion of the specified Metro Sub-unit. Tag sales follow the same availability schedule and fees noted above.

### Junior Antlerless Deer

- Available to youth ages 10-17.
- One tag is included with the purchase of a Junior archer/crossbow deer license and one with the purchase of a Junior gun deer hunting license. Two tags are included with a Junior Conservation Patron license.
- Valid statewide on the land type specified on the tag, **except in Ashland, Forest and Sawyer counties**, and during any open gun, archery or crossbow season.

### Metro Sub-unit Antlerless Deer

- Issued upon request, at no cost, with the purchase of an archer/crossbow and gun deer license.
- Valid in the DMU, Metro Sub-unit and land type (public or private) specified on the tag.

## Buck carcass tag types:

### Bow Buck Deer

- Valid in any unit statewide for tagging a buck deer that has at least one antler which is 3" or longer in length.
- This carcass tag **is** weapon-specific to either a vertical bow or crossbow. It can only be used with a valid archer and/or crossbow deer license during an open archery or crossbow season except when an antlerless only firearm season is underway. This tag is valid to use with either weapon when an archer or crossbow license is purchased at the regular price and the other is obtained by purchasing a \$3 upgrade. See the *2016 Wisconsin Deer Hunting Regulations* for details.

### Gun Buck Deer

- Valid in any unit statewide for tagging a buck deer that has at least one antler which is 3" or longer in length.
- This carcass tag is **not** weapon-specific and is valid for tagging a buck deer killed with a firearm, crossbow or vertical bow under the authority of a valid gun deer license **during the November 9-day gun deer season (extended in metro sub-units), December muzzleloader season, special hunts for youth and disabled hunters.**
- Class A & C disabled permit holders and certain active duty military personnel on leave may use this tag during any firearm deer season including antlerless-only firearm seasons to tag a buck only. See the *2016 Wisconsin Deer Hunting Regulations* for details.
